

ADVANCED TRAINING IN REMOTE INDIGENOUS HEALTH

NT REMOTE GENERALIST PATHWAY

Are you a General Practitioner with a Fellowship looking to improve your knowledge and skills? Are you looking for a change that will provide a unique, fulfilling, meaningful experience and an opportunity to make a difference in Indigenous health?

The Advanced Training in Remote Indigenous Health program has been developed as a pathway option for an additional Advanced Specialist Training (AST) component for a FACRRM, or the Advanced Rural Skills Training (ARST) for the FARGP.

Course participants will have the opportunity to work in a remote community with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in the Northern Territory.

Training will be comprehensive and specific to the community worked in, with locations being identified in collaboration with AMSANT / NT health services and through individual participant preferences.

This opportunity is possible through a collaboration between Flinders NT Regional Training Hub, Central Australian Aboriginal Congress, NT General Practice Education, Aboriginal Medical Services Alliance Northern Territory and Northern Territory Primary Health Network.
