Summer Research Award

Summer Research Award Guidelines

The Summer Research Award has been established as an opportunity for students interested in studying for an Honours degree in Business, Criminology or Government in the College of Business, Government and Law to undertake a research project supervised by a member of staff. There are six Summer Research Awards available to high achieving students.

Prior to applying, the applicant will need to find a supervisor for their project. This is likely to be, but does not have to be, the same academic staff member as the Honours supervisor.

The timing of the research project will take place during the summer vacation period and will be determined by the applicant and their supervisor.

This award is solely for educational purposes. The recipient is under no obligation to perform any work nor are they required to attend at the University or elsewhere, at any particular time. There is no intention to create an employment relationship.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be a current undergraduate coursework student. Preferably the student is enrolled in, or considering enrolment in, an Honours degree.

SELECTION

The Summer Research Awards are assessed and selected on academic merit by academic staff members of the College of Business, Government and Law.

BENEFITS

The award benefit is up to \$1500 for the duration of the research project.

The award benefit will be paid in two instalments: at the start of the research project, and at the completion of the research project. For the awardee to receive the final payment, the awardee's supervisor must send an email notifying that the awardee has completed the research project to cbgl.hdrstudents@flinders.edu.au.

DUE DATE

The application is to be emailed to cbgl.hdrstudents@flinders.edu.au and is due by Friday 26th November 2021 COB.

The application must be filled out correctly and co-signed by the supervisor as per the form. <u>Late</u> applications will not be considered.
