

DEGREE STRUCTURE

Our online Bachelor of Business consists of 108 units of study. Students will undertake the following:

- 40.5 units of core topics
- 54 units of business topics
- 13.5 units of electives

You can also complete an honours program as an additional year (or the equivalent part time)


